Enjoy the show!

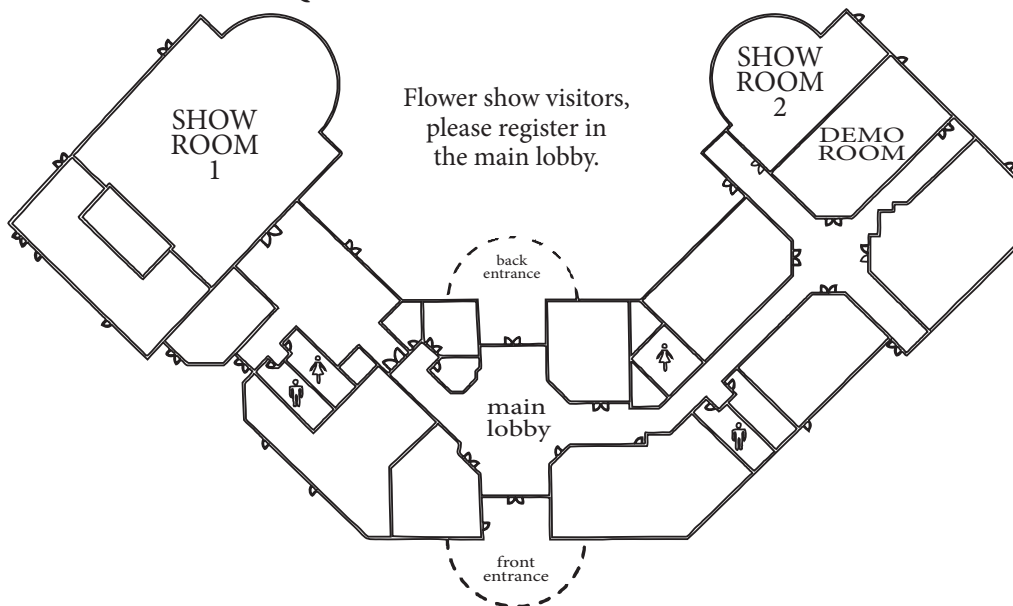
